AN EVENING WITH MORRISSEY: EXCLUSIVE TO VIVID LIVE DURING VIVID SYDNEY **BALLOT DETAILS**

Morrissey to perform exclusively for Australian audiences during Vivid Sydney as part of Vivid LIVE at Sydney Opera House on Tuesday May 26, Wednesday May 27, Saturday May 30 and Sunday May 31, 2015

Destination NSW and the **Sydney Opera House** today announced British popular music visionary **Morrissey** will perform four exclusive performances at **Vivid LIVE** during **Vivid Sydney**, the Southern Hemisphere's largest festival of light, music and ideas.

"An Evening With Morrissey" will take place at the Sydney Opera House on 26-27 May and 30-31 May and will be the artist's only Australian appearances.

Destination NSW Chief Executive Officer Sandra Chipchase said, "**Vivid LIVE** is set to wow audiences once again with the announcement of influential indie musician, Morrissey as the first artist on this year's program. As one of music's most enduring figures, Morrissey is set to captivate audiences in his Sydney-exclusive performances during **Vivid Sydney**."

Vivid Sydney, the Southern Hemisphere's largest festival of light, music and ideas, is owned and managed by the NSW Government's tourism and major events agency, **Destination NSW**. **Vivid LIVE** at the **Sydney Opera House** forms part of the **Vivid Music program** and is a celebration of ambitious popular music, running from 22 May - 8 June, – the first time the program has run for the duration of **Vivid Sydney**. **Vivid LIVE** is the highlight of **Sydney Opera House**'s year-round contemporary music programming.

Morrissey is one of popular music's most singular and iconic figures. Variously described as an irrefutably bleak or gloriously funny songwriter, **Morrissey**'s romantic narratives immortalise the post-industrial recession of '80s era Manchester through to the current day. The crooning legend continues to create art across multiple mediums to the delight of his devoted fans, from the instant Penguin Classic *Autobiography* to his critically acclaimed 10th album *World Peace Is None of Your Business*.

With high demand expected for this Sydney-exclusive performance, tickets will be allocated through a ballot (details below).

Now in its seventh year, **Vivid LIVE** will be overseen by **Ben Marshall**, the Opera House's **Head of Contemporary Music** and recently appointed as the Curator for **Vivid LIVE**. Ben













has brought the likes of The National, Nick Cave & the Bad Seeds and Flying Lotus to the **Opera House Concert Hall** stage.

Ben Marshall, Vivid LIVE Curator at Sydney Opera House said *"I am honoured to be taking on this role after Fergus Linehan's sensational run and cannot wait to release the full program. Vivid LIVE as part of Vivid Sydney is a wonderful opportunity to transform the Opera House inside and out – it's the only time contemporary music is able to take over the whole House.*

"I'm thrilled that the first announcement for Vivid LIVE 2015 is a Sydney-only residency by the uniquely gifted and inimitably stylish Morrissey. I have vivid teenage memories of his face all over our lever-arch files in high school. So it's amazing to now showcase his artistry on the Concert Hall stage. These four vital, intimate concerts will be a very special occasion for all those like-minded souls who've been affected by Morrissey. But get in early, as these concerts will sell out."

NOTES TO EDITORS:

BEN MARSHALL

With a career spanning almost 20 years in the Australian independent music scene, Ben Marshall cut his teeth as a solicitor by day and electronic music promoter by night, throwing himself into what is now considered a classic period of drum 'n' bass. At 27, he shed the legal path and moved to independent music company Inertia where he set-up and ran Civil Society (now Handsome Tours), beginning his close relationship with **The National** and bringing the likes of **Grizzly Bear** and **The xx** to Australia for the first time.

Currently responsible for the Opera House's contemporary music programming, the Opera House's year-round contemporary music program, and co-curating **Graphic Festival**, recent years have seen seminal Australian acts **Nick Cave & the Bad Seeds, Dead Can Dance** and **The Dirty Three** make their long-overdue debuts at the Opera House, while genredefining artists such as **Bonnie Prince Billy, Violent Femmes, Yo La Tengo** and future-facing electronic artists **James Blake**, **Flying Lotus** and **Caribou** have transformed one of the world's most iconic stages with their unforgettable performances under the Sydney Opera House sails.

Warren Ellis (Nick Cave and the Bad Seeds, Dirty Three, Grinderman) said, "Two of the great thrills of my performing career have been playing at the Sydney Opera House, quite possibly my favourite building in the whole world. This has been solely due to the tireless campaigning of Ben Marshall. Since his instalment as Head of Contemporary Music, Ben Marshall has managed to open the doors to groups like Nick Cave and the Bad Seeds, Dirty Three and many others, in attempt to honour the artistic beats in contemporary music, as is de rigueur in the equivalent European and American concert halls.

"The building was built to reflect the cultural aspirations of its society and it's essential that the programming reflect the lifeblood of contemporary music rather than the traditional arts centre presentations. What an amazing gift for the performers and audience alike.

Flying Lotus aka Steven Ellison said, "Ben Marshall recognised the potential of our show in a venue that wouldn't normally invite an artists like myself and the result was better than we could have imagined. "I've always loved the magic in art and music and try to figure out how to make every show fresh and original – the space you're playing always makes a difference, sometimes on a subtle level but in certain spaces it can have a huge influence on the event, playing the Opera House was like that for me, we already had a great show but it just came to life inside that space."
