ROAD CLOSURES

CBD, Circular Quay, Darling Harbour, Haymarket, The Rocks and Walsh Bay will be closed and parking restrictions will be in place. Roads will start closing from 5pm each night of the festival with additional closures on Fridays and weekends. All roads will re-open by 1am each night. Check the map on the reverse of this flyer for more detail. Access to your property will be affected while roads are closed as vehicles are not permitted to exit a driveway or carpark onto a closed road. Please plan ahead and familiarise yourself with the closure locations and times. Relocate your vehicle outside the closure and clearway areas if required as once closures are in place, no vehicle movements will be permitted until roads have safely reopened.

SPECIAL EVENT CLEARWAYS

Special event clearways will be in effect on various key



roads in the city between 3pm and midnight each night. Clearways are strict no-parking zones and apply even to local residents and Mobility Parking Scheme permit holders. Check signs carefully as vehicles left in clearways will be towed and a fee

applies. If your vehicle is towed, call the Traffic Information Line on **132 701** to find its new location.

PEDESTRIAN ACCESS

Given the fluid nature of the Light Walk through some of Sydney's most spectacular CBD precincts, there are varying foot-traffic capacities in different areas of the route. That is why Vivid Sydney will have a one-way pedestrian flow in some areas of the Light Walk to keep foot-traffic moving and reduce potential congestion. There are many places to start and rejoin the Light Walk, giving visitors many options to plan and adjust their journey. Visitors are asked to observe instructions given by marshals and volunteers, and pay attention to the variable message signs, which will be regularly updated. GETTING AROUND THE CITY DURING VIVID SYDNEY

All Vivid Sydney locations are easily accessible by public transport and additional services will run throughout the festival period. With major road closures and parking restrictions in place, the best way to travel is by public transport. Make sure you have a valid Opal card and top it up online before you travel to avoid queues at top-up machines. You can also use a contactless major debit, credit card or linked device to tap on and off transport services.

Buses and light rail services in the city will be affected and will use different stops while roads are closed for the event. Keep in mind that ferries are a popular way to travel during Vivid Sydney and typically reach capacity on weekends, so plan a back up option, too. Please follow the health advice and wear a face mask when travelling on public transport.
