

MOBILITY & SENSORY MAP

Inigorating the city of Sydney with awe-inspiring art installations and 3D light projections, the Vivid Light Walk transforms our urban environment into a kaleidoscopic wonderland.

In 2023, Vivid Sydney's free Light Walk is a massive 8.5km adventure covering Circular Quay, The Rocks, Walsh Bay Barangaroo, Darling Harbour, Darling Square, Darling Quarter, The Goods Line and Central Station.

See the city anew with 60 light attractions, including 26 international works.

Vivid Sydney is owned, managed and produced by Destination NSW, the NSW Government's tourism and major events agency.

Given the fluid nature of the Light Walk through some of Sydney's most spectacular CBD precincts, there are varying pathway capacities in different areas of the route. That is why Vivid Sydney will have a one-way pedestrian flow in some areas of the Light walk to keep people moving and reduce potential congestion. Visitors are asked to observe instructions given by marshals and volunteers, and pay attention to the variable message signs, which will be regularly updated.

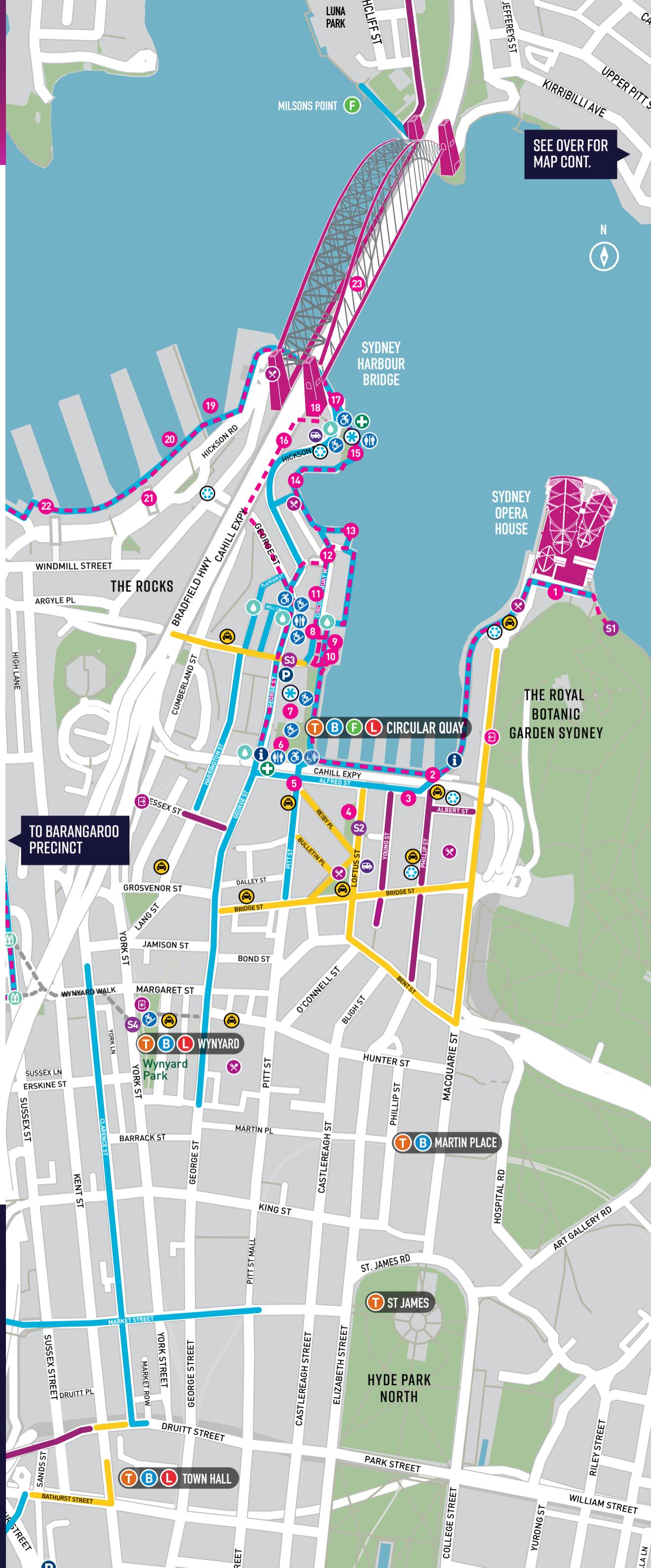
